Do you know that the Leamington Half Century Centre was established as a Canada Centennial project? The Leamington and District Half Century Club was incorporated on May 4, 1966. The official opening of the Club's building at 38 Mill Street West took place on May 2, 1967. By September of that year the membership had grown to 239.

In July of 1970 the Club moved to its current location on Talbot Street East. The west room addition was completed in November of 1973, and the billiard, storage, and board rooms were opened for use on October 8, 1980. On May 15, 1992 our official name was changed to the Leamington & District Half-Century Centre, Inc.

This in very condensed form, covers 53 years of the Centre's existence, and takes us to the recently completed renovations. I hope you will all enjoy the "new" facilities, and invite you to attend the "Reopening of the Centre" on November 8. Despite joyful highs and troubling lows, the Centre has maintained its objectives of helping seniors to enjoy their leisure time.

As we approach the Christmas Season I urge you to remember the members who are ill or confined to their homes. Lift their spirits with a phone call or friendly visit.

The 3rd Tuesday each month we have Pot Luck. Cost is \$8 per person, or \$4 if you bring food.


