Located off of historical Talbot Trail which hugs the north shore of Lake Erie in Chatham-Kent, is where you could find what people said was the most photographed home in southwestern Ontario and across Canada. On July 21, 2023 this house was torn down. The house was built between 1840–1850. Peter Anderson now owns the house that was purchased by his grandparents Roy & Ethel Guyitt in 1908. Although Anderson can't keep up the home, he keeps the lawn mowed and watches over it to honour his grandfather. As kids he remembers coming here on weekends to get haircuts and a bath and we watched television.




